

Voter ID Information

Photo ID is not required in any election in 2019.

Beginning in 2020, North Carolina voters will be required to provide photo identification when voting in person or absentee-by-mail, with some exceptions.

The following documents are acceptable Photo IDs for Voting in 2020. If you have any of these documents, it is **NOT** necessary for you to have a Voter ID card made at the Board of Elections office.



- Driver License or Non-Operator ID from North Carolina**
- Must be valid and unexpired OR expired for one year or less
 - May be expired if voter is over the age of 65 and ID was unexpired on their 65th birthday



- Driver License or Non-Operator ID from a Different U.S. State or Territory**
- Acceptable ONLY if voter registered within 90 days of the election
 - Must be valid and unexpired OR expired for one year or less
 - May be expired if voter is over the age of 65 and ID was unexpired on their 65th birthday



- United States Passport**
- Includes U.S. Passport Card
 - Must be valid and unexpired OR expired for one year or less
 - May be expired if voter is over the age of 65 and ID was unexpired on their 65th birthday



- Military ID Card or Veterans ID Card**
- May be used even if expired or if there is no expiration date.

Some Employee ID cards, Student ID cards, and Tribal Enrollment Cards have also been approved for Voting in 2020.
